



**FINAL PLAN
JULY 1, 2005 TO DECEMBER 31, 2015**

I. INTRODUCTION

The Reading Downtown Improvement District Authority (DID) was created in 1995 in response to employees' and business owners' repeated requests for a cleaner, safer downtown Reading. For nearly ten years Reading DID has provided services which are beyond the capabilities of the municipality and yet critical to the economic growth and success of the City of Reading. Through a special assessment, levied upon all commercial properties within the District, downtown Reading is a cleaner, safer and more inviting place to live, work and visit. Although a sunset provision included in the initial 1995 Plan limited DID authority to five years, in June of 2000 80% of eligible property owners voted in favor of a five-year extension through June 30, 2005. In May and June of this year, assessed property owners will determine whether DID should continue for 10 more years; a term of service that will increase the ability to attract outside funding and achieve greater cost effectiveness. This document is the final plan for Reading DID and outlines accomplishments, proposed changes and required renewal procedures.

II. BACKGROUND

The Reading Downtown Improvement District Authority was organized pursuant to the Business District Authority Act of 1980, an amendment to the Municipalities Authority Act of 1945. The 1980 legislation granted Business District Authorities the power to designate improvement districts within commercial areas, develop a plan for specific improvements and, with the approval of the municipal governing body, to levy assessments to pay their costs.

In January 1995, Reading City Council adopted Ordinance 134-95 establishing the Reading DID. At the time, Council recognized that the participation of such an authority downtown was "desirable for the entire City of Reading to preserve and improve the economic vitality of the central business district." Prior to Council adoption of an ordinance approving the DID Final Plan in July 1995, over 40 meetings were held with business and property owners in the DID area. The services Reading DID provides to downtown Reading were established in those meetings. In October 2000, following an overwhelmingly favorable vote by District property owners, City Council passed Ordinance 20-2000, approving the DID Renewal Plan and extending the improvement district for a second five-year term.

Reading DID is now conducting another renewal campaign in which property owners will decide whether DID should continue based upon its past performance and proposed changes. Several changes to DID are being proposed, including a ten-year duration and expansion of the District (see Map for expansion area). In addition, Reading DID is proposing that Reading City Council incorporate modifications to the structure of DID by designating the Reading Downtown Improvement District as a Neighborhood Improvement District (NID) and the Reading Downtown Improvement District Authority as the Neighborhood Improvement District Management Association (NIDMA) for the District; however, the familiar Reading DID name and logo will not change. A Cooperation Agreement between the City of Reading and the Reading DID will define all activities of the DID. This restructuring, the preparation of the DID Plan and agreements will be executed according to provisions outlined in the Neighborhood Improvement District Act of 2000. Services currently provided by Reading DID will be maintained and expanded following this restructuring. Existing services and proposed changes are more fully described in the following sections. Reading City Council Ordinance 8-2005, amended Reading Downtown Improvement District Authority by-laws, Cooperation Agreement and other supporting documentation are available for review in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Reading.

III. DISTRICT DESCRIPTION

BEGINNING at the intersection of Washington Street and North Second Street; along North Second Street to Walnut Street to North Third Street to Washington Street to Madison Avenue; to Elm Street excluding 430, 432 and 438 Elm Street;

along Elm Street to Church Street to Walnut Street to Poplar Street to Washington Street to Moss Street to Court Street, excluding 906, 908, 910, 912, 914, 916, 918 and 920 Washington Street and 40 Moss Street; along Court Street to North Eleventh Street, excluding 11, 15, 17, 19, 21 and 23 North Tenth Street and 24, 22, 20, 18, 16, 14, 12, 10 and 6 North Eleventh Street; along North Eleventh Street crossing Penn Street to South Eleventh Street; along South Eleventh Street to Cherry Street to South Ninth Street, excluding 1013 Cherry Street, 25, 23, 21, 19, 17, 15, 13, 11 and 9 South Tenth Street, 915, 913, 911, 909, 907 Cherry Street, 914 rear Penn Street, and 25, 23, 21, 19, 17 and 13 South Ninth Street; along South Ninth Street to Franklin Street to South Seventh Street to Chestnut Street to Plum Street to Franklin Street, including 112 and 108 Plum and 614, 618 and 622 Franklin Street; along Franklin Street to Pearl Street excluding 514, 516, 518, 520, and 522 Franklin Street; along Pearl Street to Chestnut Street to Wood Street, excluding 521, 519, 517, 433, 431, 429, 427, 425 and 421 Chestnut Street; along Wood Street to Franklin Street to South Fourth Street to Cherry Street to Carpenter Street to South Third Street, excluding 341, 339, 337, 335, 333, 331, 329 and 327 Franklin Street and including 30 South Fourth Street; continuing along Cherry Street to South Second Street to Franklin Street, excluding 27, 25, 23, 21, 19, 17, 15, 13 and 11 South Second Street; along Franklin Street to South Front Street to North Front Street to Washington Street to North Second Street, place of BEGINNING.

Upon request and careful investigation, the DID could be expanded geographically in the future. Any changes to district boundaries will be accompanied by an amendment to this Final Plan.

IV. PROCEDURE/TIMELINE

Reading DID will follow a similar process (outlined below) for this restructuring as for the previous renewal in 2000. Only legal owners of assessed properties within the district will be eligible to approve the ten-year Reading DID plan.

1. January and February 2005 – RDIDA staff prepared and mailed preliminary plan; Reading City Council adopted restructuring ordinance; ~~and~~ amended by-laws, services agreement for renewal period with City of Reading prepared.
2. March and April 2005 – Advertise and hold public hearing(s) for preliminary plan.
3. April 2005 – Prepare and mail final plan; advertise and hold public hearing for final plan. Begin 45 day voting period.

4. June - Reading City Council adopts Ordinance approving final plan.

A negative vote by 40% or more of eligible property owners is required to defeat the renewal of Reading DID. An objection shall be registered in writing with the Reading City Clerk within 45 days of the presentation of the final plan. Each eligible property owner shall be entitled to one vote for each parcel of land owned.

V. TERM

The RDIDA will operate for ten years and six months from July 1, 2005 through December 31, 2015. The ten-year plus six month term will align the authorization period with the annual budget for DID and the City of Reading and is being proposed because the RDIDA believes that the property assessment and other revenue should be used toward providing services to the downtown and not for a renewal campaign every five years. The longer term will also enhance opportunities to obtain outside funding for service improvements.

VI. FUNDING/BUDGET

Funding for DID services comes from several sources, primarily a fee on property value assessments, but also cash and in-kind contributions, fee-for-special services, and marketing efforts. The current assessment rate of 4.754 mills is *not* proposed to change in 2005. However, increased income is expected from additional properties in the expanded District, as well as voluntary contributions from nonprofit organizations in the DID. Improved marketing of the fee-for-services activities such as security, cleaning and employee escorts will supplement assessment income.

The 2005 estimated assessment income from the 440 assessable properties in the DID will be approximately \$450,000, which is approximately the same as 1996 and represents an increase of nearly \$50,000 from 2004. The anticipated increase is from the addition of 150 properties located in an expanded DID area paying the 4.754 mills rate. It should be noted that 80% of the assessment revenue in 2004 came from just 17% of properties. The 2005 budget is conservative on the income from tax-exempt properties, which are being encouraged to make voluntary contributions. Of the \$300 million total property assessment in the DID, \$199 million, or two-thirds, is tax-exempt properties. The billing and collection of property owner assessments will be performed by the DID Authority with assistance from the City of Reading Tax Administration and Solicitor offices. All

owner occupied residential properties will be exempt from paying an assessment fee.

In 2004, RDIDA generated more than \$531,000 in total income and will have an estimated combined income of \$622,400 in 2005. Through greater operational efficiency and cooperation with stakeholders, DID will be able to provide substantially more service to the expanded downtown district with the estimated 15% increase in revenue.

A restructured Reading DID will step up its marketing and promotion efforts by going back to its roots in the Reading Marketing Association (RMA). When DID was created in 1995, the RMA disbanded but its role in marketing downtown Reading continued with DID. Earlier efforts to promote the downtown area through a newsletter, special events and a website will be revived and expanded.

Reading DID will become more aggressive in securing funds for enhanced programming and improvements through local, state and federal grants. In January 2005, a grant application was filed with the Reading Weed and Seed Program to expand the Reading DID Ambassador and cleaning operations, develop graffiti removal and educational programs, and perform downtown business marketing and promotion. Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development grant opportunities, such as the Main Street, Elm Street, and Housing and Redevelopment Assistance programs, will be pursued. Reading DID will also seek federal Community Development Block Grants funds. No streetscape or other physical improvements are proposed for 2005.

Since DID operates on a calendar year, the 2005 DID budget approved in January 2005 includes anticipated revenue from the second half of 2005 following restructuring. The 2005 budget of \$622,400 is slightly less than the 1996 budget of

\$644,500, but substantially higher than the 2000 budget of \$518,900. Long-term budgeting, as well as strategic planning, will begin when the restructuring process has been completed. Budget projections for the remainder of the 10-year term will be presented as part of a ten-year operating plan.

VII. PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

Reading DID currently provides Ambassador, Escort, Cleaning and Marketing services to property owners, businesses, employees, residents and visitors in downtown Reading. These services are in addition to municipal services currently provided by the City of Reading pursuant to a municipal services agreement. The level of services the City of Reading provides to the downtown will not be reduced. The agreement, detailing the duties and responsibilities of both Reading DID and the City of Reading, is available for review in the Office of the Reading City Clerk. The following is a summary of those services.

Reading Police Department:

The present level of police services in the DID boundary area shall be maintained or increased, and shall not fall below the present level.

Department of Public Works:

Street sweeping, plowing and repairs shall be maintained at current levels. Leaf and garbage removal, landscaping, and assistance with hanging banners and decorative lighting will be provided as needed.

By special arrangement the Ambassador, Escort and Cleaning services are available for special events, beyond DID's normal operational hours and in areas contiguous, but outside the DID area. The services provided by DID will be maintained at least at their current levels throughout the ten-year term. However, the additional revenue anticipated in 2005 will be allocated to expand services.

A. Administration of RDIDA is by an Executive Director and Administrative Assistant in offices currently located at 645 Penn Street. Following renewal in June 2005, DID offices will be relocated to street-level facilities in the BARTA Transportation Center at 701 Cherry Street. It should be noted that administrative costs for 2005 will increase to 32% of expenses from 2004 due to one-time charges for renewal, strategic planning, and relocation, as well as moving workers compensation insurance into Administration. Administration would be 26% of expenses without

the one-time charges associated with this renewal campaign.

B. The Ambassador Service provides a variety of public safety and good will activities year round. Ten Ambassadors, also known as Community Service Personnel, serve as the “eyes and ears” of the Reading Police Department, communicating directly with police dispatch. The Ambassadors circulate on foot and on bicycles throughout the downtown district from 7:00 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. weekdays, 9:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. on Saturday, and on special occasions (primarily events at the Sovereign Center and the Performing Arts Center). The Ambassadors patrol six parking garages, and respond to nearly 700 calls each month for assistance in incidents ranging from lost children and disorderly conduct to shoplifting and auto accidents. Ambassadors also act as goodwill representatives of downtown Reading, meeting and greeting visitors and supplying information such as directions to events, restaurants and businesses. DID Ambassadors make daily business checks to many of the more than 400 businesses in downtown Reading. Ambassadors are available as additional security at special events. It is anticipated that following Reading DID renewal in June 2005, this service will be expanded. With increased revenue from an expanded assessment base (see Section V above), two new Ambassadors would be hired and the operating hours of the service extended to midnight on Fridays and Saturdays, as well as several hours on Sundays. Approximately \$231,000 (37%) of the 2005 DID budget will go toward the Ambassador service representing a net increase of \$34,000 in funding over 2004.

Overall crime has decreased since 2002 within the DID area as reflected by a 49% drop in non-Police assisted calls and 38% lower for Police-assisted calls. However, loitering, skateboards and bicycles continue to be a problem in Penn Square representing 70% of non-Police assisted calls in 2004. Signage restricting bikes and skateboards in Penn Square and the courtyards, as well as a zero tolerance policy by District Ambassadors, has contributed to the 33% decline between 2002 and 2004.

Escort services are part of the Ambassador program. Reading DID provides free escort services within the downtown 7:00 am to 11:00 p.m. weekdays and 9:00 am to 5:00 p.m. Saturdays. The Ambassadors receive approximately 3,500 calls annually to escort employees from office buildings and stores to nearby parking lots and garages. For a fee, this service is also available

beyond DID’s working hours and in areas adjacent to the District. Note that approximately 10,000 people receive escorts annually.

Of all the services provided by RDIDA, the **daily business checks** by day and night shift Ambassadors provides the most direct contact with business and property owners downtown. With more than 400 businesses downtown, Ambassadors visit approximately 30 businesses every working day. By contract with the Reading Parking Authority, Ambassadors also patrol public parking garages.

C. Cleaning and Maintenance Services are handled by full- and part-time DID employees with assistance by volunteers from Berks County Prison. This year round program utilizes a variety of techniques to clean sidewalks, streets and other public areas downtown six days a week between 7:00 am and 3:00 pm. With additional full- and part-time cleaning personnel hired in 2005, a variety of mechanical cleaning equipment will be operated on a daily basis, contributing to a cleaner downtown. Throughout the DID, pole mounted “Smart Cans,” which can be rotated for emptying, have been installed to help reduce the amount of litter downtown. Over the next year twenty more “Smart Cans” will be installed within the expanded district. In a typical month, the cleaning crews fill approximately 1,000 bags of trash collected from the “Smart Cans” and other trash containers, as well as litter from streets. The 2005 RDIDA Budget more than doubles the funds allocated for cleaning and maintenance from \$76,000 to \$154,000.

D. Marketing and Promotion. The intent of the marketing component of Reading DID has been to build on the existing quality events and festivals in and near downtown. Later this year DID will institute a wide array of marketing projects, some of which were undertaken by the former Reading Marketing Association. Although Reading DID had dramatically curtailed its marketing program in 2004 by eliminating the Marketing Director position, part-time student interns will be hired in 2005. Reading DID will continue to present the annual Holiday Parade and summertime MidDay Café series, update the Downtown Reading website, begin publishing a monthly newsletter/event calendar, and organize new special events throughout the year. Beginning this year, several educational campaigns will be initiated promoting public safety and cleanliness downtown. A public relations campaign using local television and print media was started in March 2005 to inform the public of the services DID

provides and that downtown Reading is an exciting and safe place to work, visit and invest.

Partnering with local organizations to develop a comprehensive marketing effort, Reading DID will create and maintain an inventory of downtown businesses, including the availability of retail, office and residential space. Cooperative advertising and special events will be developed to attract more people to visit downtown. Several downtown walking tours will be established to get people re-acquainted with downtown Reading as the cultural center of Berks County. With almost 20 pieces of public art including murals, sculptures and stained glass, a new art gallery on Penn Street, several downtown artist studios and the new Goggle Works arts center opening in September 2005, art lovers from near and far will be attracted downtown. There still exist in the downtown area many fine examples of historical architecture, as well as three historic districts. The historical walking tours previously developed by the City of Reading Historic Preservation Office will be revived and promoted, giving locals and visitors an opportunity to experience some of the best Reading has to offer.

E. Long-term Strategic Planning

Following renewal in June 2005, the RDIDA will seek assistance in the preparation of a long-term strategic action plan to act as a blueprint for implementing the new programs and services outlined in this renewal/restructuring plan, as well as enhancing current services and expanding the overall RDIDA program. The long-term plan would also identify additional income opportunities from outside sources.
